## Definitions – Type of Activity

### Non-Contact

This includes both training and competitive games where the Rugby Canada National Law Variations apply. Tackling, rucking, mauling, scrummaging and lineouts are not permitted in non-contact rugby.

### Contact

This includes both training and competitive games where the World Rugby Laws of the Game apply and/or Rugby Canada National Law Variations. Contact may involve, tackling, rucking, mauling, scrummaging and line outs.

### Mixed Ability Rugby

Mixed Ability Rugby can be played as either a contact or non-contact game. The contact game follows the traditional World Rugby Laws with minor variations to support all those participating. Tackling, rucking, mauling, line-outs are all permitted but scrums are uncontested. The non-contact game abides by the World Rugby Tag Laws and is played with flags. Tacking, rucking, mauling, scrummaging and line-outs are not permitted in the non-contact game.

## Definitions – Athlete/Player Memberships

### Minor Rugby Player:

Any athlete participating in minor level competition and/or training. Please refer to the [Rugby Ontario Age Group by Birth Year Matrix](#) for clarification on type of rugby to be played at each age.

### Junior Rugby Player:

Any athlete participating in junior level competition and/or training. Please refer to the [Rugby Ontario Age Group by Birth Year Matrix](#) for clarification on type of rugby to be played at each age.

### Senior Rugby Player:

Any athlete participating in senior level competition and/or training.

**Masters Rugby Player:**

Any athlete participating in masters level competition and/or training (over the age of 35). Please refer to the [Rugby Canada Law Variations for Masters Rugby](#).

**Non-Contact Membership:**

Any Junior, Senior or Masters athlete participating in touch or flag competition and/or training – participant must upgrade membership accordingly if playing in contact competition.

**12 Week Membership:**

This membership offers an opportunity for a Rugby Club to offer a non-contact program of rugby for up to 12 weeks. Specific restrictions apply (non-upgradable membership category).

**Off Season Contact:**

This is a contact membership category for Junior or Senior players, restricted to a specific duration (January to April). Registrants are eligible to participate in club specific programming/training only for the months the category is active. Participants must upgrade membership accordingly if participating further once membership expires in April.

## Definitions – Management Memberships

**Board Member**

An individual who is part of a group of people who jointly oversee the activities of a member club/organization.

**Coach**

An individual that leads and/or assists with the coaching of an athlete or team in either a training or competitive environment in accordance with World Rugby Laws of the Game and/or Rugby Canada National Law Variations.

**Coach of Match Official**

An individual that coaches a match official in either a training or competition environment in accordance with World Rugby Laws of the Game and/or Rugby Canada National Law Variations.

**Match Official**

An individual who is responsible for enforcing the World Rugby Laws of the Game, and/or Rugby Canada National Law Variations, during a competitive match or in a training environment.

**Manager**

An individual who is assigned to a club/team for the purpose of facilitating administrative duties.

**Medical**

An individual who is responsible for being the first responder to an injured participant in either a competitive match or training environment.

**Volunteer**

An individual who assists in club activities, which may include but not limited to game day parking volunteers, event volunteers and or minor festival volunteers. A volunteer cannot perform the role of a coach, assistant coach, match official or medical staff.

**Social**

A non-participation membership for any person who is a supporter of a club. This membership does not have any exposure to the National Insurance Program.
